GOLF



RULES

- **Number of Competitors:** Open based on registration not to exceed maximum number of players permitted on course.
- **Age:** Players play in increments of 5 years starting at age 50
- **Format:** Tournament consists on one round, 9 holes of golf
- **Rules:**
 - **START TIME IS FORFEIT TIME**
 - All rules of golf as specified by local course will apply.
 - Each foursome/twosome, based on registration, will be assigned a hole from which to begin and a SHOTGUN START will begin play.
 - All players are required to use a cart for play.
 - Score cards will be validated by the official scorer at the end of the round.
 - Each player must furnish their own clubs/balls.
 - Range finders are permitted.
 - USGA rules for play will be followed with exceptions of rules specified by local course.
 - Triple bogey is the maximum number of shots permitted on a hole. (Par + 3 additional shots). Player must enter # and pick up ball in order to expedite play if they have not completed the hole.
 - In the event of a tie medals will be awarded to both players.

Medals are awarded when all players have completed the round
