

Gwinnett Senior Golden Games
Meeting Minutes
January 9, 2012

Alan opened the meeting and led the group in an invocation, followed by the Pledge of Allegiance. He then welcomed those attending and thanked the personnel at Bethesda for providing a meeting place.

Elaine reported the current balance of \$18,978.45.

The Event Managers' luncheon at Delmar Gardens will be February 16th. At that time a check for \$125 will be presented to Delmar for contribution to the cancer fund.

Alan read a list of possible entertainers for the Opening. Hank will contact names on the list after the Board has chosen three or four possibilities.

Susie announced that it had been determined that there were 148 people participating in 2009 who did not participate last year. She brought the registration forms and asked the attendees to pick up theirs. The remaining will be mailed to participants. A suggestion was made that registration forms could be put at Health Clubs in the area, as well as Sporting Stores. Alan presented a flyer done by Larry Hanna. It was suggested that a flyer be taken with registration forms.

Alan noted that there was an article about the games in the January H2U newsletter, as well as the current Gwinnett Life magazine. He has sent information to a number of periodicals.

It was decided that Pickle Ball will be presented as a demonstration sport at the 2012 games. It can be held at Lucky Shoals Park. A Venue Manager will have to be secured.

The Event Managers will have collared shirts, and a number of colors were discussed. The Board will make this decision. Glory will call Dana with the shirt color chosen.

A gift selection has not yet been made. This decision can be made a few weeks before the Opening.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned. The Board will meet right after adjournment.
