RULES

- **Objective**-Complete the course in the least number of strokes.
- **Rules of play**-Players begin at designated start stake and strike the ball with the mallet through the wickets around the course.
- **Direction of play**-Player must strike the ball following the direction of play laid out on the course and completely pass through each wicket completing the course by hitting start/finish stake.
- **Scorekeeper**-Scorekeeper will count the number of strokes it takes to complete the course. ANY movement and touching of the ball by the mallet counts as a stroke. Scorekeeper's decision is final in all matters.
- **Person with the lowest score is the winner in each 5 (five) year age division and gender division.**
- **The event of a tie, dual medals will be awarded.**
- **Medals will be awarded at the end of the tournament.**
- **Decision of the event manager is final.**
